

 - Assisting them in lining up and assembling after recess






Please be punctual.

POCKET MONEY:


- Suggested amount is \$2 (for recess only)/

- Purchase a lightweight bag






Do take note...

1	Labels All belongings (e.g. books, files, water bottle, stationery, wallet, shoes, etc.) had been labelled clearly with your child's/ward's name and class.	
2	School Bag The following items had been packed into the school bag. • Pencil case • Water bottle • A storybook • Colour pencils • A homework folder # School bag had also been packed according to the "Things to Bring List 2023" which was attached.	
3	Haircut Your child/ward has had proper haircut. Note: Boys must have neat haircut. Long hair for girls should be tied and plaited. Only black hair accessories are allowed.	
4	Dismissal Your child/ward had been briefed on who would be fetching him/her upon dismissal or whether he/she would be taking the school transport. If your child/ward is taking the school bus, the bus number should be indicated on the plastic name tag (after your child/ward has received it on Day 1).

3	Reporting Time Your child/ward has to report by 7.20 a.m. on the first day of school. Subsequently, the reporting time is 7.25 a.m.	
4	Assembly Area Your child/ward is to assemble in the School Hall according to his/her class. Teachers will be there to lead the Primary 1 students.	
* 5	Recess time Recess timings for the P1 classes on Day 1 are staggered from 8.30 a.m. onwards. *refer to Orientation Slides sent via email/Parents Gateway/on school website.	
	Subsequently, the P1 recess is from 8.30 a.m. to 9 a.m.	
	<u>Note:</u> Parents/Guardians are allowed to be in the school for recess only on the first day . You are to remain along the sides of the canteen.	
6	Dismissal Point Parents/Guardians are to fetch your child/ward from Gate 3 (near to Blk 508) during dismissal.




